SHOPPING DINING ENTERTAINMENT HISTORICAL SITES

Downtown Sacramento has many museums and historical sites to visit. Listed below are a few of the historical sites that are in walking distance or bus ride from the hotel:

- Old Sacramento (shopping and restaurants)
- California State Railroad Museum
- State of California Capitol Building and grounds
- Governor's Mansion
- Leland Stanford Museum
- State Indian Museum
- Sutter's Fort
- State Museum and Historic Parks
- Crocker Art Museum

The hotel is within walking distance of the Westfield Downtown Shopping Plaza. There are over a hundred stores with Macy's being the anchor store. The Westfield Downtown Shopping Plaza has a movie theater and many different restaurants.
